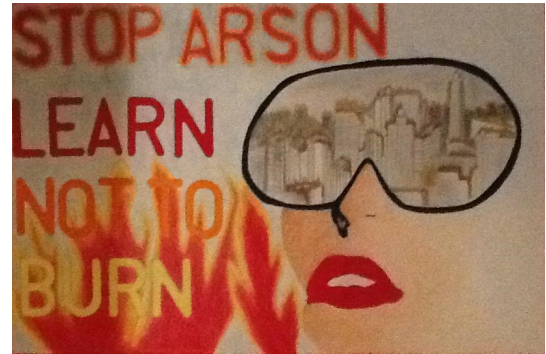
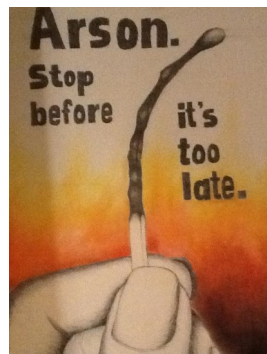

OFFICIAL RULES

Eligibility:

The middle school category is open to any Michigan student enrolled in grades 7-8. The high school category includes students in grades 9 -12. The computer generated category is open to any students enrolled in 7-12.

Deadline:

Posters must be postmarked before midnight on March 15, 2017 and arrive in the Delta Township Fire Department by March 22, 2017.

Mailing:

Posters must be wrapped flat and mailed to Michael Roberts, Delta Township Fire Department, 811 N. Canal Rd. Lansing, MI 48917.

Poster Specifications:

1. Posters must be submitted on poster board.
2. The overall dimensions shall be approximately 15" x 20".
3. We will not accept posters created by more than one person.
4. All posters will become the property of the Michigan Chapter of International Association of Arson Investigators, Inc., unless a request for return is made in writing.
5. Posters will be judged based on theme, spelling and illustrative quality.
6. Posters that have been burned in any way will be disqualified.
7. No photographic reproduction of any individual can be used.

Identification:

(The following information must be on the back of the poster.)

1. Artist's name, age and grade and email.
2. Artist's home address and telephone number.
3. Name, address and telephone number of school.
4. Name of art instructor or classroom teacher, if any.
5. The category you are entering.
